The 2010 Auburn Recreation Program is scheduled to begin on May 3, 2010. Rosters are due by 3:30 PM on Monday, April 5, 2010.

1. All managers, players are responsible for becoming knowledgeable of the rules. Once a roster is completed and filed with the Department of Public Works, that manager is agreeing that he/she has read the rules, is acceptant of the rules, and has informed his/her players of the content and application of those rules.
2. All entry forms accompanied with the proper fee charge are to be submitted to the Department of Public Works office by Monday, April 5, 2010. Each entry will be dated and numbered upon being submitted. **You will need separate checks for the forfeit fee. Both checks should be made payable to the City Treasurer. Both of these fees will be paid at the same time to the Department of Public Works.**
3. The MAXIMUM number of teams per division will be:

4. ENTRY FEES:

All Leagues		\$160

5. Roster:
  - A. Typed or printed roster, nonresident fee and forfeit fees must be submitted on or before April 5, 2010. Checks for entry/nonresident fees must be made payable to the City Treasurer. All rosters will be closed with all player names included on or before April 5, 2010. Any changes to the roster after April 5 must be reviewed and approved by the Superintendent of Public Works and Sports Coordinator. Each roster must include at least twelve names. Players whose names appear on more than one roster will be committed to that team once his/her name is entered on the score sheet for the first game that he/she participates. Managers are solely responsible for the accurate completion and maintenance of their roster. Any violations will result in suspension and termination of players or teams.
  - B. A responsible team manager must be designated on the roster prior to submittal. It is requested that cell phone number, home phone numbers and work number (if possible) and complete addresses of the managers be supplied so that rain out schedules, cancellations, rule changes and playoff schedules can be mailed or the manager contacted. The Department of Public Works is not responsible for tracking down managers.

6. Player Eligibility:
  - A. Anyone residing within the City of Auburn city limits.
  - B. Residents of Cayuga County, not residing within the city limits of Auburn, will be assessed a \$30 fee per player. Non-county residents will be assessed a \$60 fee per player. **THESE FEES MUST ACCOMPANY TEAM ROSTER.** This fee **will not be refunded** for any reason.
  - C. **ALL** players must be able to show proof of residence (drivers license, registration, school I.D., etc.) within 48 hours upon request of the Sports Supervisor or the Department of Public Works.
  - D. All players must be at least 17 years of age by July 1, 2010, to participate in any league.
  - E. Any player found violating any part of Rule #6 will be suspended from further league play and all games said player participated in will be declared a forfeit. The team managers will be responsible for making sure their team members bring in proof of residency to the Department of Public Works upon request.
7. Switching Teams:
  - A. A player may switch teams with approval from the Superintendent of Public Works and Sports Coordinator to an upwards division. ie a B Slow Pitch player may switch to B Major Slow Pitch or A Slow Pitch.
  - B. An A Slow Pitch player **may not** switch to a **B Major** or **B Slow Pitch team**.
  - C. A B-Major player **may not** switch to a B League division team.
  - D. Players will not be permitted to laterally switch teams during the season unless approved by the Superintendent of Public Works and Sports Coordinator and only under extenuating circumstances.
  - E. Players are not permitted to play with more than one team in the slow pitch classification.
    1. An over 40 player may participate on one team in the A, B Major or B-League.

Any player found to be in violation of rules five, six or seven will be fined \$40.00 and an automatic two game suspension. Further violations will result in possible termination.

8. Any protest or appeal of player eligibility rules must include appropriate documentation that includes dates of violation, teams, copies of score sheets, etc. In addition to the appropriate documentation, a \$25 protest fee will be charged. If the protest is upheld, the fee will be returned.
9. The Sports Supervisor will decide on which teams advance to the "A", "B" or "C" leagues for the 2010 season. The City of Auburn Department of Public Works reserves the right to place teams in the various leagues depending on skill level of the players. Previous year records, roster evaluation, player representatives will be methods that will determine placement and classification of teams in the various leagues.

The City of Auburn Department of Public Works reserves the right to cancel leagues and refund sanction fees if the leagues are unable to form in the appropriate classification of skill level. The City of Auburn also reserves the right to determine how many players from a refunded team may join another team to compete in a different league.

10. Teams may purchase softballs through the local ASA Umpires Chapter. The umpires will have a table set up during the April meetings so that teams may purchase the balls. In addition, the umpires will provide additional dates so that teams may purchase the balls. All team managers are requested to buy enough ball to cover the season and playoff schedule. The designated ball for fast pitch is the Trump Ball MG-50 with cork center and the slow pitch ball is the Trump ball with polycore.
11. Schedules will be mailed to team managers the week of April 19, 2010. The team managers will be responsible for extra copies for the other team members.
12. The Softball meetings will be held at the Casey Park Recreational Facility, 150 North Division Street, Auburn. All meetings will be held on Monday, April 12, 2010. The meeting times are as follows:

All Men's Slow Pitch	6:00 p.m.
All Women's teams	6:45 p.m.

13. The home team is responsible for recording wins and losses on the master schedule. The master schedule is located on the Casey Park Office window or at the fields in the utility boxes behind the backstops. All teams are requested to check their individual wins and losses on a regular basis to ensure proper and accurate recording. Do not wait to the last game of the season to review your current standings, as it may become too late to be included in the playoffs.
- \*\* Teams will not be contacted by the softball coordinator to ascertain whether a game was won or lost. Those incomplete games will result in losses to both teams and team manager will accept the responsibility.**
14. The Herman Avenue fields will be issued one set of bases for the season. Failure to return the bases to the box at Field #1 by the home team manager and loss of those bases will not be the responsibility of the Public Works Department. Teams will become responsible for supplying bases upon loss of city issued bases.
15. Managers and/or players of those final games being completed on any given night are requested to ensure that the lock is secured on the utility box after recording the win/loss and placing the bases in the box.
16. In all Slow Pitch Divisions, the plate will be part of the strike zone. Any pitched ball striking the plate, in the air, will be called a strike.
- 17.
- A. All adult players may play with one team in slow pitch classification. Below listed you will find the formula that sets forth this policy:
  - B. Over 40 players may play in A or B Major slow pitch divisions. Schedules will not be altered to accommodate playing times. Schedules will not be altered to meet the needs of individuals so that they may play in various leagues.
  - C. Any player found to be in violation of Rule #17A or #17B will be fined \$40 and an automatic two (2) game suspension will follow. The second team in which the player participated will receive a forfeit. Any team may question player eligibility. However, an official protest, which includes documentation, must be lodged with a \$25 protest fee.
18. Games must start when scheduled, as long as any nine players are present. No out shall be declared if a team begins a game with nine in the absence of a tenth player. In slow pitch, a tenth player, whose name is already on the roster, may enter the game prior to the completion of the fourth inning. Without the appropriate number of players, teams may wait ten minutes, after which, game is forfeited.
- A. In slow pitch a team may play with an extra player (EP) who may enter the game as a defensive player. That player who leaves the defensive position then becomes the (EP). No alterations to the batting order will be permitted unless a player enters the game as a fresh substitute.
    - 1. Once a team starts with the 11 player (EP) they may finish with 10 or 9 players. However, an out will be declared in that player's spot that leaves the game.
    - 2. Once a team starts with 10 players and loses player(s) to an injury or ejection, that spot in the batting order will be declared an out.
- No team will be allowed to play with less than 9 players.

### 19. HOME RUN RULE:

The Department of Public Works will continue with a home run rule from last season.

A and B Major Division – Each team will be allotted three homeruns per game. Once team A hits the 4<sup>th</sup> homerun, team B must match their 4<sup>th</sup> home run. If team A hits the 5<sup>th</sup> home run before team B hits their 4<sup>th</sup> home run, it will be declared an out. Teams will be allowed to match each other with unlimited home runs.

B Division – Each team will be allotted two home runs. Any further homeruns after the 2<sup>nd</sup> will result in outs.

Teams are notified that the game will continue with a back-up ball after each homerun. At no time should a game be stopped to retrieve the ball. The umpire will be responsible to enforce this rule. If there is violation of this policy, the rule will be terminated and we will finish the season with the past homerun policy.

### 20. FORFEIT POLICY:

All men's and women' leagues are required to pay a \$60 forfeit fee *to the City of Auburn*. This forfeit fee will be refunded at the completion the season barring any forfeits during the season. In the event of a forfeit, the umpire fee will be deducted from the offending team's forfeit fee. The nonoffending team will **NOT** be responsible for payment of the umpire on that evening. A second forfeit will result in payment of the remaining forfeit fee and suspension from further league play.

21. A. Each player plays at his own risk. Any injuries sustained are paid for by each individual or group.
- B. **Blood Rule:** Any player who is injured during the contest and is bleeding from said injury will be removed from the game until such time as the bleeding has stopped. That player must remove all clothing, which has been bloodied by the injury, prior to re-entry into the game.
- C. Failure to adhere to the Blood Rule will result in ejection of the player from the game.

### 22. PROTESTS:

- A. Protest must be made at the time of the decision in question to the umpire. Protest must be written and forwarded with a \$25 deposit to the Department of Public Works within 24 hours. If protest is upheld, the fee will be returned.
- B. Protest must quote section, paragraph, and number of rule violated, as it appears in the 2010 A.S.A. Rule Book.
- C. The Sports Supervisor and/or Arbitration Board will decide all protests.

23. Any conduct not considered sportsmanlike, or to the best interest of the program, will not be tolerated. Such players will be ejected from the game, and even from the league, if the Sports Supervisor deems it necessary. Ejection will mean automatic one-game suspension. Any/all players ejected from a game are required to pay a \$40 re-entry fee to the Recreation Office prior to the next scheduled game. Any player ejected a second time will be suspended from league play for the season **OR** will be suspended for an indefinite amount of time! The above applies to individuals as well as teams. Unsportsmanlike action includes any verbal or physical abuse directed at another player, a fan or umpire; i.e., swearing, pushing, intimidation, etc. This rule will be in effect before, during and after games. Violations of this rule will be automatic forfeiture of games involved.

24. ASA Softball Rules will prevail, unless otherwise stipulated, with ground rules stipulated by umpires. Any rules violation will result in games being forfeited. Any changes regarding rules and regulations must come from the Sports Supervisor.

25. Slow Pitch teams will be dressed in conforming colored shirts **ONCE** the season begins!

### 26. Ball Rotation:

- A. Ball Rotation - All Men's Divisions: Two new balls shall be delivered to the umpire at the beginning of the game. The umpire will enforce the A.S.A. ball rotation policy.
- B. Women's Divisions - one new ball & good back up ball shall be delivered to the umpire at the beginning of the game. Quality of back up ball will be left to the discretion of the umpire, if deemed unacceptable, a new ball must be provided.
- C. Scorekeepers - all teams will be issued an official A.S.A. scorebook at the beginning of the 2010 season. The home team designated on the schedule will be mandated to maintain the official score.

27. In case of inclement weather, the Department of Public Works will be responsible for cancellation of games up until 3:30 p.m. of the day in question. The decision will **NOT BE MADE UNTIL AFTER 3:00 P.M.** After 4:30 p.m., teams must report to their scheduled field site at game time, at which time the umpire will determine if the game is to be played or not. **THE UMPIRES DECISION WILL BE FINAL!** At any field with multiple games per night, once a game is cancelled, the remainder of that night's games are cancelled. The softball hotline number is 255-4119.

28. All recreation softball games must be played as scheduled or declared a forfeit. Games will not be rescheduled for any reason, with the exception of rained-out games. Those teams who cancel games on their own by contacting the other team, that game will be declared a forfeit.

29. Winning team's manager or representative will be responsible for publicity. He will make sure that the box score and details of each game are turned into the Citizen no later than 7:00 a.m. the day following each game.

30. A player must play in two games to be eligible for playoffs, unless otherwise stipulated by the Sports Supervisor.

### 31. PLAYOFFS:

In the past, schedules have been supplied by the Recreation Office. We have experienced many problems with inaccurate, unidentifiable, & unintelligible standing recordings by the teams. In addition, many playoff berths were not settled until games are played on the last night of the season. This caused many problems as teams were not prepared to begin playoffs the following Monday.

To address and possibly resolve these problems, playoff schedules will be determined during the weekend (following the final night of the season) and supplied to the Department of Public Works early Monday morning. Team managers will be responsible for securing the schedule by contacting the Department of Public Works.

**There will be no calls made by the Department of Public Works to those team managers who failed to secure the schedule!** The playoff schedule will begin the following week promptly giving all teams an opportunity to make arrangements with their individual players.

32. Playoffs will be limited to the pennant winners, runners-up or determined by the Sports Supervisor.

33. The ten run, five-inning rule, will prevail in all slow pitch games. The eight run rule is in effect for fast pitch. In slow pitch, if either team leads by ten or more runs after five innings, the game will be awarded to the team with the most runs. In fast pitch, if either team leads by eight or more runs after five innings, the game will be awarded to the team with the most runs. The ten run rule will be in effect for the playoffs.

34. Any team allowing team members or spectators to consume alcoholic beverages during any game will be subject to suspension, forfeiture of games or both. Team managers or captains are responsible to see that this rule is enforced.

35. Schedules will not, we repeat, will **NOT** be altered! Early schedule distribution will allow you to avoid any/all schedule conflicts. Inability to conform to this master schedule is a concern of yours and will not be the concern of this department. The early release of said schedule is a convenience to one and all.

36. The enclosed rules and A.S.A. rules will govern league play.
37. UMPIRE FEES:  
Slow Pitch:
  - a. Each slow pitch team will be responsible for paying the umpire \$15.00 prior to each game. Failure to comply with the payment of umpires prior to the game will result in termination from further league play.
  - b. The officials will keep the initial fee and complete the rescheduled game if a game in progress is stopped due to rain, etc.
38. **IN ALL SOFTBALL LEAGUES**, metal cleats or football shoes will not be permitted. Anyone violating this rule will be subject to ejection from the game.
39. All existing preceding rules and regulations are subject to change, modification, and/or alterations by the Sports Supervisor ONLY! These changes, modifications and/or alterations are made in conjunction with the Board of Arbitration. The Board of Arbitration will consist of the following:
  1. Softball Coordinator
  2. Superintendent of Public Works
  3. Executive Board (Umpire)
  4. Player Representative

### **THE FOLLOWING RULES PERTAIN TO THE "OVER 40" "LEAGUE ONLY:**

1. Umpires servicing the 2010 "Over 40" Division will be given a copy of the rules/by-laws germane to said division.
2. Extra player (EP) is the choice of the offensive team, thus creating the 11<sup>th</sup> offensive player.
3. A courtesy runner shall be allowed - one per inning for any reason. The courtesy runner must be the last recorded out (or the player scheduled to bat last if in the first inning with no outs) and must be entered prior to the first pitch to the next batter.
4. **SLIDING IS NOT ALLOWED!!!! (UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES!!!)**
5. All home plate outs will be treated as follows: Runners must touch the second home plate located adjacent to the right handed batters box in order to be safe at home. Defensive players can only touch the original home plate and runners can only touch the 2<sup>nd</sup> home plate. Runners tagged by the defensive team will not be out. If the runner touches the original home plate, he will be out and the ball will remain alive.
6. Base runners are allowed to over-run bases. (Treat each runner as if a runner is running to first base and beyond).
7. Conforming shirts are required by all teams!!!
8. Metal cleats are not allowed!!!!
9. The Trump ball will be used during the 2010 season, ordering TBA
10. Fifteen (15) run rule is in effect after 5<sup>th</sup> inning. In addition, this applies to playoffs
